### Fishing Run Planting Day—April 26th

**We need your help.** The final phase of the Fishing Run Restoration/Maude Mine Reclamation Project is fast approaching. We are currently signing up volunteers to help us plant approximately 4000 bare-root trees and shrubs at the project site. **Groups as well as individuals are encouraged to attend.**

Instructions regarding plant handling as well as plant placement will be provided on the day of the event.



**This is a great way to get out and celebrate Earth Day and Arbor Day!** The trees and shrubs will provide stream bank stabilization as well as a riparian buffer for the newly relocated stream channel.

**Planting Day kicks off at 9:00 a.m.** Follow the signs along Millers Run Road to the project location.

Beverages and Pizza will be provided for the volunteers.

This event will be rescheduled in the event that poor weather prior to/or the day of the event causes the stream bank to become too saturated to walk upon without causing damage, so please register for this event by April 14th.
